In the 1980s, children's fitness in kindergartens was limited to basic activities like jumping and passing the ball. The approach was often unstructured and unmeasured. As Singapore's affluence grew, coupled with a decline in physical activity, childhood obesity became an increasing concern.

Recognizing this challenge, Kinderland became the first preschool to introduce a comprehensive international approach to its fitness programme, now known as "KinderFit". Beyond physical fitness and cardio-wellness, this programme educates children on the importance of nutritional values, safety, and hygiene through the music-infused curriculum. With that, Kinderland launched the annual combined sports day to celebrate and reaffirm our belief in children's wellness in their early years.

Our toddlers, aged 12 to 17 months, are excited to participate in the Sports Fiesta for the sixth year running! After training hard for two fun games, "Parachute Party" and "Happy Todds Quest," they are ready to shine.
