KINDERLAND MARCHING BAND'S 15TH ANNIVERSARY

The Band's Journey: A 15-Year Celebration

The story began in 2010. Inspired by a nursery school in Osaka, Japan, Kinderland educators envisioned creating a similar musical experience at home. With determination and creativity, Singapore's first preschool marching band was born.

From humble beginnings with just a handful of young performers, the band grew steadily, drawing children from multiple Kinderland centres. In 2015, its 5th anniversary was marked by a memorable performance at a national festival—an event that firmly cemented its place in the community.

As the band celebrated its 10th anniversary in 2020, it had become a signature programme of Kinderland. Kinderland has been a pioneer in the musical journey for preschool education in Singapore.

Since its formation in 2017, Kinderland's preschool stage ensemble has opened doors for more young talents to shine through music. Over the years, they have had the honour of performing at prestigious platforms such as the Early Childhood Development Agency, People's Association, and Esplanade. This year, our ensemble proudly brought joy to audiences across the island with heartfelt performances at National Day celebrations, showcasing the spirit and creativity of Kinderland children.

COLOUR GUARD

For the third-year running, the Kinderland Colour Guard lit up the Sports Fiesta with a spectacular display of rhythm, coordination, and unity. The performance highlighted not only our children's musicality and movement but also their growing confidence and teamwork. Through the Colour Guard, our young ones continue to strengthen their bond with music and movement, inspiring all who watched them.

On 11 October 2025, over 800 children, parents, and educators gathered at the Singapore Institute of Management Sports Hall for the Kinderland Sports Fiesta. The event offered an engaging platform for families to connect, play, and celebrate learning through physical activities.

SUPPORTING OUR NATION THROUGH THE DECADES

In the late 1980s, the Ministry of Community Development (MCD) encouraged employers to set up child care facilities in workplaces and office buildings, to entice mothers to re-join the workforce. Workplace child care services provided mothers with peace of mind, thereby increasing productivity, and reducing absenteeism and job-hopping.

Recognising the demand, Kinderland opened its first workplace childcare centre at Temasek Polytechnic in 1996 to support the initiative. Since then, it has partnered with key institutions and today operates centres in several government workplaces, including the Ministry of National Development, Ministry of Manpower, and Revenue House.

Through these developments, Kinderland has continued to play a pivotal role in supporting working parents while nurturing future generations.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

At Kinderland, community partnerships are an important part of our holistic education approach. We believe children learn best when they are connected to the world around them. Through collaborations with government agencies, community groups, and local organisations, our preschools create opportunities for children to engage meaningfully beyond the classroom.



Kinderland Singapore was proud to join the Ministry of Manpower (MOM) on 8 August 2025, in celebrating our nation's 60th birthday at this year's National Day Observance Ceremony (NDOC). The celebration was graced by Guest-of-Honour Dr Tan See Leng, Minister for Manpower. CULTURAL DIVERSITY: OUR JAPANESE COMMUNITY

A VIBRANT JOURNEY IN JAPANESE- ENGLISH BILINGUAL LEARNING

Launched in 2020, the Kinderland Japanese-English Bilingual Programme has become a hallmark feature at Kinderland Preschool @ Marine Parade. What began with three children has grown into a thriving community of young learners from Pre-Nursery to Kindergarten two in 2025. This steady growth reflects families' confidence in our programme that nurtures future-ready citizens with a heart.

Daily lessons with English and native Japanese teachers help children stay connected to Japanese culture while building strong foundation in English language. Enriching Japanese festive celebration, and hands-on cultural experiences deepen their understanding of traditions and cultural customs. At the same time, learning alongside peers from diverse backgrounds encourages children to embrace cultural exchanges and broaden their worldview. Children develop an appreciation for Singapore's multicultural environment and learn to respect different perspectives.

CELEBRATING CULTURE, COMMUNITY, AND TOGETHERNESS

Kinderland Preschool @ Marine Parade has become a warm, welcoming home for both native Japanese and mixed Japanese families. Parents are regularly invited to join centre festivities, strengthening home-school partnerships and creating memorable shared experiences.

A highlight this year with children arriving in colourful *yukata* or *jinbei*, was our Summer Festival celebration held on 25 July 2025. The celebration opened with a lively *Bon Odori* dance performed by our kindergarteners, with parents joining the familiar circle dance.

Families also enjoyed decorating their own *uchiwa* (Japanese hand fans), and participated in the highly anticipated *suika-wari*, a traditional watermelon-splitting game. Filled with music, creativity, and meaningful parent-child bonding, the event beautifully reflected the strong and supportive community spirit that defines Kinderland Preschool @ Marine Parade.

GO GREEN SG 2025

A vibrant mural made from reused plastic toys was unveiled on 2 July 2025 at Promenade MRT Station to support the Go Green SG movement and celebrate Singapore's 60th birthday. Titled "Building Our Nation Over Generations", the mural was completed by Ms Goh Han Yan, Senior Parliamentary Secretary of the Ministry of Sustainability and the Environment, alongside partners SMRT Trains, YTL PowerSeraya Pte Limited, and Lions Befrienders. The artwork involved the creative efforts of over 5,000 preschoolers and 5,000 family members and educators from Kinderland's five education brands: Kinderland, ELFA, NurtureStars, Skool4Kidz, and The Grange International Preschool.

GIVING BACK TO THE COMMUNITY

LIONS BEFRIENDERS REVOUGE PROJECT

The mission of Lions Befrienders (LB), founded in 1995, is to ensure that seniors lead meaningful and enriching lives.

Since 2018, Kinderland has proudly partnered LB to build meaningful connections between our preschoolers and the seniors. These interactions allow children to foster empathy through the senior's life experiences, helping them grow into compassionate global citizens. At the same time, children bring joy and wonder to the lives of seniors, creating bonds that transcend generations.

In 2025, Kinderland and LB launched ReVogue, a creative initiative blending “recycle” and “vogue.” Through upcycling activities, old fabrics were given new life, made into reusable bags and toilet roll holders, lovingly sewn by the seniors. As part of the annual Start Small, Dream Big (SSDB) and ReVogue projects, our preschoolers raised SGD\$18,888, contributing to meaningful community impact.

Through these projects, our children learned the value of empathy, creativity, and community, while experiencing the joy of giving and making a difference.
